## **Advent Group Ministries STEP UP! Referral Procedure FREMONT Site**

- 1) Advent receives referral form + student's facesheet (Infinite Campus), class schedule and attendance records.
- **2) Advent** will contact the Referrer (within 48 business hours of receiving the referral) to coordinate a face-to-face interview/screening with the student.
- **3)** Face-to-face Screening meeting\*. Purpose of meeting is to assess the student's level of drug use and appropriateness for treatment and determining their willingness to participate. Participation is defined as:
  - i. Regular and consistent individual/ group attendance
  - ii. Regular and consistent individual/ group engagement (interacting with others in group and journaling on our <u>7 Challenges</u> days)

- **4)** Once the student agrees to participate within this framework of our program:
  - a. Advent will notify the referrer of outcome of the meeting
  - b. Advent will schedule a 60-90 minute intake with the student.
  - c. If student consents, we encourage parent or guardian to attend this meeting so that they can understand how the program works and encourage parents to participate (optional).
- 5) Typically, students will meet individually with counselor for two more sessions (these are lengthy assessments) before they begin attending group.
- 6) Once enrolled in our program (Step Up!):
  - a. Individual counseling sessions will be provided at student' school site (Cupertino/ Homestead) / FUHSD Office (589 W. Fremont)
  - b. Group sessions (if applicable) will be provided at FUHSD Office.

Due to Federal Confidentiality Laws: Updates will be provided to school referrer/ counselor to the extent where student has provided written consent, and via secured method (Telephone, TigerConnect-secured web message portal)
